We are losing the battle against crime! The government is unable to provide sufficient adequately equipped policemen to protect and serve us, so it is up to the community to take greater responsibility for protecting and serving itself.

A means of achieving this is through Sector Policing, an approach to policing whereby the service area of a police station is divided into smaller, more manageable areas known as sectors. The sector commander then involves the community in identifying the policing needs of the sector and dealing with the root causes of crime and factors contributing to crime. This in turn leads to sound partnerships between the police and the community.

Did you know that an average of 30 - 40 serious crimes are reported every month in the Bryanston East (Sector 2) area?

By having an active policing presence in the sector we can start to reduce crime and make our area a safer environment for our children and ourselves.

How can you help?

- By making a monthly donation of R100 (or more) towards purchasing and maintaining 3 police vehicles for our sector which will be dedicated to policing our community, and other community initiatives. This will go a long way to helping secure our sector, which has multiple entry points thereby encouraging opportunistic crime;
- By attending Sector Crime Forum (SCF) meetings on the first Thursday of every month at St Michael's Anglican Church, corner of Mount Street and Bryanston Drive at 18h30 to discuss crime prevention action plans with the sector commander.

We have registered a Section 21 company (not for gain) to spearhead this fund-raising initiative (company registration no. 2004/011551/08) and manage any funds raised on behalf of the community. Similar initiatives in other communities have been very successful in combating crime and raising funds for the community, so let's all contribute to making the Bryanston East Community Forum a success!
